

How to Change a SIBA Fuse

we can

1. De-energize the equipment following bank manufacturer's instructions.
2. Isolate the equipment from system.
3. Ground the equipment.
4. Wait at least 5 minutes to proceed to the next step.
5. Locate the fuse that has operated by finding the fuse where the red striker pin has extended.
6. Open fuse clips and remove the fuse that has operated.
7. Place the new fuse in the holder ensuring the end with the red striker pin (there is a white sticker on the end) is on the end with the micro switch.
8. Ensure fuse clips close all the way.
9. Remove the equipment ground.
10. Place the equipment in service following the manufacturer's instructions.
